A graduate of Daemen, class of 1959, Caroline was the longest-serving board member in the college's history, serving an impressive 42 years (1976-2018), including 10 years as chair. She was a tremendous advocate for the college and a dear friend to the Sisters of St. Francis. The college saw substantial growth and momentum during her long tenure as a trustee.

A prominent attorney in Buffalo, Caroline earned her law degree from the University at Buffalo. She was a past Chair of the Erie County Bar Association Surrogate's Court Practice and Procedure Committee and an active lecturer and instructor at several Western New York institutions. Caroline was also committed to serving the community through participation on numerous councils and committees, including the United Way of Buffalo, the Erie County Department of Mental Health, and the Citizens Advisory Salary Commission for the City of Buffalo.
